Friendly Reminders for Resident Safety

For the safety of residents, team members, and visitors, we ask that all cigarettes and lighters be brought directly to the nurses' station for recording and safekeeping. Our primary concern is always the well-being of your loved one. If not monitored properly, these items can put residents at a tremendous risk.

There are designated smoke times which are carefully supervised by staff. Having a record of all smoking paraphernalia allows staff to better observe and attend to residents during their smoke break.

All over-the-counter (OTC) medications are treated in the same manner as prescription medications and are kept on the nurses' cart. These are closely monitored, administered, and recorded by the nurse.

If your loved one needs OTC medication, please speak with a nurse. We ask that you not bring OTC medication to a resident. It is Encore's policy to remove any prescription or OTC medication from residents' rooms to ensure the utmost safety for everyone.

We appreciate your cooperation in keeping everyone safe and healthy.

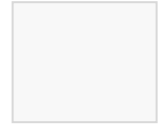
